Saint-Emilion Grand Cru Classé

January 2019 – Weinwisser
18/20

April 2018 – James Suckling
92-93/100

A solid and layered red with blackberries, wet earth and spices. Cloves. Medium to full body, ripe tannins and a juicy finish.

April 2018 - Wine Spectator – James Molesworth
90-93/100

Solid plum and boysenberry compote flavors form the core. Licorice snap and fruitcake notes fill in the background. Lively acidity pulls all the elements together.

April 2018 – Markus del Monego
91/100

Dark purple red with violet hue and black core. Expressive nose with distinct roasting aroma, elegant fruit, dark berries and plums. On the palate well balanced with ripe tannins, freshness and elegance, persistent finish.

April 2018 – WineDoctor – Chris Kissack
92-94/100

The fruit was picked between September 14th and the 30th, with a yield of 30 hl/ha. The vinification was traditional, in cuves, with malolactic fermentation and élevage in barrels, 50% new, 50% second-fill. This has a rather restrained, slightly dusty character to the nose, perfumed, with lovely fruit ripeness behind it, black cherry laced with a little dark chocolate. There follows a supple start to the palate, with black cherry and spiced plum, with a tense, stony, mineral confidence wrapped up in it. Cool, fresh, and filled with grippy tannin which persists through the long finish. This is very good indeed.
